BASIC MEMBERSHIP BENEFITS:

\$5,000,000 Personal Liability Insurance; \$30,000 Accident, Death & Dismemberment (A.D & D.) Insurance providing 24-hour, worldwide coverage for permanent injuries. **Must be under the age of 90 years.** Liability insurance for transporting non-owned horses, maximum of \$10,000 per horse, \$50,000 per accident. Quarterly Alberta Bits magazine; access to scholarships for students attending accredited universities and colleges; access to scholarships and grants for equestrians who have achieved excellence in both English and Western riding. Membership is non-refundable and expires December 31st.

The AEF also works in partnership with other associations or individuals to develop clinics and workshops that help horse people across the province get professional advice and assistance in sport, health, welfare and community projects. Our aim is to annually increase our involvement, support and funding for clinics, workshops and special events.

DEFINITION OF OPTIONAL INSURANCE COVERAGES AND MEMBER PROGRAMS

Members Named Perils (MNP)

Insurance coverage for your own horse(s) in case of death resulting from fire, lightning or collision/overturn of a conveyance in which a horse is being transported. This insures up to a maximum of \$4,000 and can be applied regardless of the number of horses owned. Losses are restricted to one claim per year

Enhanced Personal Liability (EPL)

The *non-commercial* care, custody and control of up to a maximum of 3 non-owned horses in any environment. Valuable coverage in circumstances such as:

- Emergency boarding situations. (Example – the displacement of horses due to a catastrophic event like flood or fire)
- The neighborly and *not-for-profit* housing of up to 3 non-owned horses on a short or long term basis.

Additional Accident, Death & Dismemberment (ADD)

Provides an **ADDITIONAL** \$50,000 Principal Sum A. D. & D. coverage that includes extended benefits for Fracture & Dental. (Under age 70)

*** It is important to note that unlike other types of insurance, A. D. & D. policies "stack" - meaning that if there is a loss covered by more than one policy, *both* or *all* of the policies respond.

Travel (out of Province/Country) Coverage (TVL)

Provides \$1,000,000 out of province/country coverage for Medical/Hospitalization. Trips up to 90 days in duration, any number of trips/year, worldwide and does NOT EXCLUDE participation in and/or preparing for equine activity/competition. **Many policies in the market do exclude such activity.** (Under the age of 70)

Members Tack (TAK)

Broad Coverage Insurance, applicable anywhere in North America, limited to \$2,500.00, payable once per term, subject to a \$500.00 deductible.

Ride & Drive Program

Riders and Drivers of all disciplines and ages log the hours spent riding or driving their horses. Renew annually and continue earning fantastic rewards for you and your horse, no matter how long this program takes you, you'll never lose your hours!

Trail Supporter Program

The Alberta Equestrian Trail Supporter Program provides recreational riders with the opportunity to support funding initiatives which support local, regional and provincial needs.
