Minutes of May Meeting

Strathcona Arabian Horse Association Strathcona Olympiette Centre Minutes of General Meeting – May 7, 2009

The **Strathcona Arabian Horse Association** –Past President Bob Klassen called the general meeting to order at 7:55 PM and welcomed the 23 members in attendance. He reviewed the fact that at the January and March 2009 meetings, the SAHA club, after 25 years, was at risk of coming to a close, unless members showed new interest and stepped forward to fill positions and volunteer for activities

A **Steering Committee** was formed and met on March 21st. The minutes of that meeting, were posted in the April Newsletter and Bob asked Wendy Zelt, the Steering Committee Chairman/ Facilitator to present the seven page report.

In summary, the committee recognized past successes, strengths and identified opportunities with a new focus going into the future. Most importantly was the need to maintain standards while improving communications, appealing to the +40 age group membership, hosting fewer events, activities and meetings, all the while upholding quality, without overloading treasured volunteers.

Due to the past appeals to encourage families and young members to join the club, the new focus is no longer on family activities, numerous horse shows, or the promotion of specifically Arabian horses.

The main purpose of the club is to bring like- minded folks together, who enjoy sharing experiences and learning about *all* kinds of horses in a social and fun atmosphere and to provide quality events and activities.

An activity plan for 2009 was compiled by the committee in addition to a list of Directors and Officers who have stepped forward offering to fill positions.

Bob asked if there were any questions or comments about the process, the results presented by the Steering Committee or about the direction of the club.

Ken Komm expressed his interest in having guest speakers at meetings.

Wendy read the list of The Board of Directors. Bob announced last call for nominations for Officers and Directors. There were none.

The Past President then asked for a vote with a show of hands accepting the minutes of the Steering Committee including the Officers and Directors. Acceptance was unanimous.

It was then voted upon, by a show of hands to accept the financial statements with a Notation that Zed and Karen will ensure amendment is complete prior to submission. Vote was unanimously in favor.

NEW BUSINESS - Meeting was then handed over to new President Phil Coatta who thanked outgoing directors for their hard work and to everyone for their support and also a special thank you to Wendy and the Steering Committee for their excellent work.
